<p><i>The AFP resources per day that have been required to provide security at or outside the Embassy of the Russian Federation in Canberra for all of 2022</i></p>	<p>The requirement for a static presence is assessed on a weekly basis by the AFP in consideration of the threat and risk environment. In this case, a patrol team was assigned to the Embassy of Russia to perform a static guard operation on a 24/7 basis from 28 September 2022 to 7 December 2022.</p> <p>On 6 December 2022 an assessment was conducted to review the environment and as such the static requirement was removed on 07 December 2022. The AFP continues to attend demonstrations at the Embassy on a daily basis as part of its business as usual methodology.</p>
