**BACKGROUND**

The Leadership in Counter Terrorism (LinCT) program is a joint program delivered by the AIPM in partnership with the AFP, Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Scottish Police College, the Police Service of Northern Ireland and the Royal Canadian Mounted Police. The program is designed to enhance the capabilities of those exercising leadership in the counter-terrorism environment and create a collaborative cadre of senior law enforcement officials who have a broad strategic global appreciation of events and intelligence and the ability to act to contribute to local, national and global counter-terrorism efforts.

The program is targeted at Superintendents and Assistant Commissioners and is comprised of 4 residential sessions including 2 x regional and 2 x international workshops. In 2023 the AIPM will host the LinCT Global program and alumni re-connection activities.

#### THE REQUIREMENT

A key theme of the 2023 program is exploration of 'public and private partnerships' in security activities. The LinCT participants amongst a number of scheduled activities, will undertake a tour of the Moore Park precinct and receive briefings on security/CT elements of NSW management of large scale sporting events. Whilst on location the group will have dinner at Allianz Stadium and also attend a NRL match, providing a unique Australian cultural experience for the international participants attending the program. A quotation has been obtained for a private suite for 47G(1) participants at 47G(1) per head on 10 June 2023. It is estimated the cost of the activity will be no more than \$16K. The cost of the activity is within budget.
