This painting shows the platypus, a unique and tenacious Australian animal that is very capable of defending itself and its family.

The platypus represents the way the AFP operates to keep Australia safe.

The platypus can pass by unnoticed, defend its territory against larger and more powerful opponents, seek out what it needs to survive and adapt to change.

The word 'platypus' is Latin for 'flat foot'. Flat foot is also an old English term for police officers, who were always on their feet.
