

You will respond to emergencies to keep the peace and preserve public safety. Whether on patrol, investigating crimes, or attending community events, you will be the face of policing in Canberra.

## Your path into ACT Policing

Pass each of these gateways to be placed in our merit pool.

- ✓ **Check eligibility and apply**  
Start your journey at [police.act.gov.au/careers](http://police.act.gov.au/careers)
- ✓ **Entrance exam**  
You will take a series of online tests, including cognitive ability tests.
- ✓ **Fitness assessment**  
You will be assessed against the required physical standard.
- ✓ **Employment Suitability Questionnaire**  
You will provide us with more details about your character, background and traffic history.
- ✓ **Assessment centre**  
You will take part in team-based activities, scenarios and an interview.
- ✓ **Security assessment**  
Your suitability to access official and classified information will be assessed.
- ✓ **Health assessment**  
Your physical and psychological health will be assessed.



## Eligibility

To be an ACT Policing officer, you must:

- be aged 18 years or over
- be an Australian citizen
- hold a valid full or provisional Australian driver's licence
- hold at least one of the following qualifications:
  - a Year 10 Certificate and 2 years of work experience
  - a Year 10 Certificate and a nationally recognised vocational education qualification at a Certificate III level or higher
  - a Year 12 Certificate
  - a vocational education or university qualification at a Diploma level or higher.
